Bob Jackson via telephone conference call reported a spill in Gas City at the Sonoco gas station at 103 W Main St on 4/19/16. Approximately 900 gallons of gasoline had been and was continuing to leak into the sanitary sewer. IDEM was immediately advised. The residents in the area were advised of the possible threat. Several residents called reporting a smell of gas. Every report was responded to and investigated. Bob stated that the over flow system was working but an old unknown septic system was effecting progress. He stated that the clean-up effort reached explosive levels twice during the four day event. Marion Fire was called for the use of their remote camera to find the actual problem. They were eventually able to stop and contain all contamination. Participants were IDEM, IDHS, Gas City Fire, Gas City Utilities, Marion Fire, Marion Utilities, Grant County EMA & Homeland Security, Delaware County EMA and ERS. Bob stated that each responding unit will need to produce an itemized invoice of time and supplies used for reimbursement purposes.

Dean moved to approve the minutes from 3-16-16. Seconded by Pam. Motion carried.

Tom has converted the Treasurer's report to Quicken. The report balances as of May. He stated that the State and Grant County match.

Bruce stated that Jerry Waggle will be appointed as an industry representative. He was not able to attend today. Casey Lemons was present. No action was taken.

A roster was passed around to add or delete information regarding LEPC members.

Bruce stated that the requirements of publication notice, fiscal report and bylaws were met as of March 1, 2016.

Bruce stated that House bill 1090 will change LEPC Committee members will no longer be considered State employees. The LEPC will now be considered a County Committee. This will go in effect July 1, 2016. The LEPC funds will still be controlled by the LEPC Committee members.

Bruce stated that Resilient Strategies LLC was currently working on the 1<sup>st</sup> draft of the Communication Plan. Bruce stated that the LEPC was required to match \$1656.00 of the grant. He stated that they already had \$1800 as of April 6 for that purpose.

Bruce stated that TIER II reports will now be reported directly to the State. He will have access to the records via the website but will no longer have to accept report and/or handle any problems. Tom added that the site will notify the county if any changes are made but that portion was not currently operating as of now.

Duaine moved to approve the Treasurers Report. Seconded by Dean. Motion carried.
