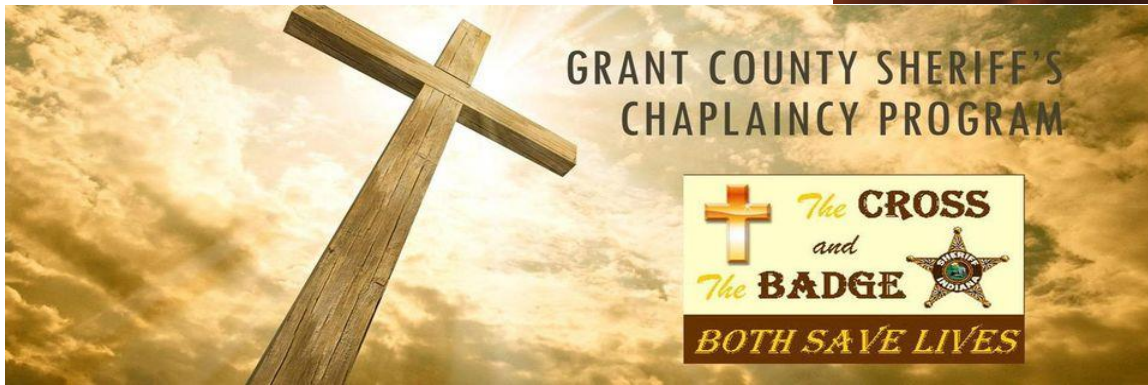

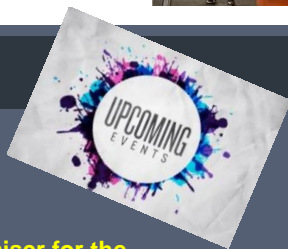
Chapel
