April 30, 2020 Daily Briefing

0900 Daily Briefing;

The Grant County Health Department has reported 139, confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 10 deaths in Grant County.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 17,835 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 1,007 deaths and 94,998 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

Yesterday MCS distributed over 37,000 meals. Civil Air Patrol officials will be coordinating with Brian Sharp for future food distributions. The next MCS food distribution will be Wednesday May 6th, from 4 to 6 PM.

Also, 2nd Harvest food bank will be having a food distribution Friday, May 1st 2020 in the old Sears parking lot at five point's mall starting at 10:00 AM.

The Grant County Commissioners have been working with the Grant County Health department as well as other elected officials and business leaders to develop a strategy for the reopening of businesses and government agencies in the safest possible manner. The Marion-Grant County Chamber of Commerce has developed a list of resources and best practices to assist businesses re-opening with modified restrictions still in place.
